

Membership

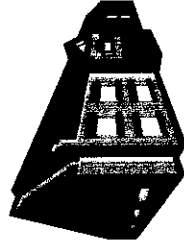

Meetings

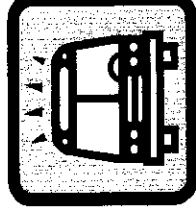
